

Rules of Use for Pedal Boat, Rowing Boat, and Electric Boat Rentals (Terms and Conditions / T&Cs)



1. A boat may only be rented by an adult. When purchasing a ticket, a valid ID card or driver's license must be presented. A boat may only be used in the presence of an adult. Any additional persons in the same boat must be at least 14 years old. Minors under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult.
2. Boats will not be rented to persons who, due to physical or mental impairments or the consumption of alcoholic beverages, other intoxicating substances, or medications, are clearly unable to safely board or operate the boat. This also applies to groups in which such a person is present.
3. The rental fee must be paid in advance in cash or by debit card (EC card). Renting boats requires the deposit of a security (driver's license, health insurance card, €20 note, or another valuable item) at the boat rental desk.
4. Boats must be returned on time. Any late return must be paid for. Early return does not entitle the renter to a refund or partial reimbursement of the rental fee.
5. Use of the boats is at your own risk.
6. The renter is liable in terms of traffic law, insurance law, and criminal law. A maximum of 5 persons are allowed in a pedal or rowing boat, and a maximum of 4 persons in an electric boat.
7. The rental company assumes no liability for any damage or injuries.
8. The rental company is released from any supervisory duties (such as wearing life jackets and behavior in the boat, etc.).
9. Accidents must be reported to the rental company immediately.
10. In the case of gross negligence or intentional damage, the renter is liable not only for direct boat damage but also for additional costs (towing costs, repairs, etc.), which may be invoiced retrospectively.

12. Jumping or swimming from boats is not permitted. There is a risk to life due to other water sports activities.
13. No liability is accepted for items left behind, lost, or forgotten by the renter.
14. The renter agrees to return boats, equipment, and life jackets clean.
15. Marked barriers and restricted areas in the water must not be entered. A distance of 30 meters must be kept from the jetty and shore. Other boats must be passed with a safety distance of 3 meters. Boats must not be chained together. Rescue boats and sailing boats always have right of way. Boats approaching from the right have right of way. Instructions from staff and rescue personnel must be followed.
16. In case of bad weather, boats must be returned immediately to the boat rental and the water and jetty must be vacated.
17. The instructions for electric boats must be read carefully in advance. By signing the operating instructions for the proper use of electric boats, the renter confirms that they have been understood and will be followed.

By paying the rental fee, these terms of use are accepted.
